I/We recognize and acknowledge that by signing this Credit Application, should my/our account with FSC become delinquent, I/we will assume as my/our responsibility any and all collection and/or attorney's fees incurred by FSC in addition to the account balances and charges that may accrue as a result of said delinquent account.

Such late payment charges will be added on the last day of each month so long as the account remains past due. The late payment charge described herein is not a finance or service charge imposed for the extension of credit or in exchange for forbearance in collecting any past due account. In addition to imposing a late payment charge, FSC shall be entitled to exercise all legal rights described in the following paragraph and/or under Guam Law:

An account that is past due will be closed to further charges until the balance has been paid in full and FSC shall be entitled to (1) execute its lien rights, (2) institute collection proceedings, and/or (3) exercise any and all other rights that it may have under law and/or contract in order to secure payment of the past due account. Any account that is inactive for 18 months or does not meet \$500 annual volume requirement will be closed.
